### Leeson House: 30th March-1st April 2020

#### Three day residential trip—Geography/ science/ history/ art & design.

Please be aware our Year 5 residential trip to Leeson House is fast looming. This trip is an essential part of our teaching curriculum; it gives us the opportunity to teach aspects of learning that can not be possible within the classroom and will be continued in the classroom on return.
